ASSISTANT GOVT. PLEADER RECRUITMENT IN FOREIGNER TRIBUNAL, BAKSA & TAMULPUR

Applications are hereby invited in standard form (Assam Gazette Part-IX) from the Indian Citizen and Permanent Resident of Assam for eligible Advocates for appointment as Assistant Government Pleaders in the Foreigners Tribunals, Baksa & Tamulpur, Assam, subject to following terms and conditions prescribed by the Government.

1. Eligibility and Qualifications:

- I. The applicant must be an Indian Citizen, as defined under Clause (5) of Article 5 of the Constitution of India.
- II. The applicant must possess a Degree in Law from a Government-recognized University and must be a member of the Bar Council/District Bar Association, as applicable.
- III. The applicant must have at least 7 (seven) years of experience as an Advocate/Pleader.
- IV. The applicant must have attained the minimum age of 35 (thirty-five) years as on the date of application.

2. Tenure of Engagement:

The tenure of an Assistant Government Pleader shall ordinarily be for a period of 2 (two) years at a time and may be renewed only on the basis of satisfactory performance, in consultation with the concerned Member of the Foreigners Tribunal.

3. Fees and Remuneration:

The rate of retaining fee, daily fee and adjournment fee payable to the Assistant Government Pleader shall be regulated in accordance with Government Notification No. PLB.41/2000/Pt/95 dated 27/06/2013.

4. Restriction on Appearance:

After appointment, the Assistant Government Pleader shall be debarred from appearing against the State of Assam during the period of his/her engagement/retainer as Assistant Government Pleader.

5. How to apply:

- I. **The last date of submission of application form through offline mode is 05/09/2026**, accompanied by the required documents and two (2) recent passport-size photographs, must be submitted in the drop box at the Office of the District Commissioner, Baksa, by 5:00 P.M (except on Sundays and other public holidays).
- II. The applicant must mention his/ her proper postal address, e-mail id and contact number/ whatsApp number on the application.
- III. Unsigned / incomplete and application without required document as well as without photograph will be rejected.

6. Required documents along with standard application form:

The application should be accompanied by self-attested copies of documents supporting the **applicant's age, citizenship, law qualification, Bar Council enrolment and professional experience** along with such other documents as may be required.
