MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE OF THE MONTH JANUARY, 2023 OF BAKSA DISTRICT HELD ON 06/01/2023 AT 11:00 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DC BAKSA.


The meeting was chaired by Smti. Masanda M. Pertin, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Baksa and at the very outset, she welcomed all officers present in the meeting.

The Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress of the developmental schemes department wise as per resolutions taken in the last meeting which was held in the Conference Hall of the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Baksa on 06/01/2023. Thereafter, threadbare discussions took place in the house and the following resolutions are adopted which are as follows :

1. **PHE:** EE, PHE, Baksa Division apprised the progress of works under JJM schemes. He said that overall of progress of JJM shemes in Baksa District is 70% till December, 2022. The Deputy Commissioner asked the team to expedite the progress of JJM in Baksa District and instructed PHE department to hand over the completed schemes as soon as possible to the Water Users Committees. The Deputy Commissioner instructed EE, PHE, Baksa Division that JJM schemes should be completed in a mission mode as MD, JJM is giving more emphasis on completion of JJM schemes and tremendous target will be given to PHE Baksa Division. The following activities shall be done from PHE Department on urgent basis ::
 - a) SHGs will be trained up for constituting Water Users Committee and handing over of completed JJM schemes shall be done in a mission mode.
 - b) 21 nos. of schemes which have been completed is required to be handed over to the Water Users Committee.
 - c) In MIS Portal the actual nos. of handing over should be reflected.
 - d) 93 villages which were selected for self assessment by the BDOs under P&RD shall be done in a mission mode.
 - e) Swachh Bharat Sarvekshan self assessment shall be done by the BDOs under P&RD upto 15th January, 2023 within two weeks with focus on water quality testing and institutional arrangements.
 - f) Liquid Waste, Solid Waste Management must be done in a mission mode under Swachh Bharat Mission.
 - g) Random inspections of implementation of JJM schemes by Magistrates.
2. **Social Welfare Officer:** Deputy Commissioner instructed the District Social Welfare Officer, Baksa to submit the list of 663 AWCs to the PHE for Water connection and APDCL authority for internal wiring with all safety measures. She also instructed PWD (Electrical) to prepare a rough estimate for all the AWCs and Schools both LP and ME. UCs with regard to PM Poshan was asked to be submitted to the Govt. on urgent basis.
3. **Health:** The Joint Director Health Services, Baksa informed the house that SID card will be arriving shortly in Health Department Baksa. He also informed the house that the nos. of Maternal death in the year of 2021-22 was 23 and 2022-23 was 8. And apprised the house that under Aspirational District Programme, Hemoglobin Meter and Glucometer have been received. Deputy Commissioner apprised the house that Health Sector has been shortlisted for PM Awards for the following initiatives - Pregnancy Tracker, Death Referral Audit and Child death referral audit. The Deputy Commissioner also apprised the house about merging of Ration Card holders with PMJAY and for that training has already imparted to all the SHGs/Aasha Workers/MPWs/Jeevika Sakhis/Bank Sakhis/Bima Sakhis JDHS, Baksa was instructed to share the list of T.B Patients to all HoDs so that they will able to adopt atleast one T.B Patient under Nikshay Bharat Scheme. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed DSWO, Baksa to distribute as much as UDID cards to the beneficiaries before arrival of Orunodoi forms on January, 21st of 2023.
4. **Food, Supply & Consumer Affairs :** The Deputy Commissioner instructed the I/c Dy. Director Supply to expedite the merging of Ration Card holders with PMJAY, Supply Inspector wise. Deputy Commissioner, Baksa also instructed the release the funds in connection with Transportation and Commission Cost to the GPSS/BSS. She also instructed all stakeholders to cooperate in achieving additional target of 1(one) lakh for new Ration Card beneficiaries.

5. **Agriculture:** The Deputy Commissioner asked the DAO, Baksa to call the Agriculture Insurance Companies when there will be meeting with Central Agriculture Minister, Gol. The DAO, Baksa informed the house that export of Honey (ODOP) has not been started and liaison is going with the companies for procurement of Honey (ODOP).
6. **DICC:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed to GM, DICC to call a meeting with all the Bank Branch Managers to expedite the progress of sanction PMEGP and PMFME loans. She also instructed the GM, DICC, Baksa to call a separate meeting on PMFME at Salbari Sub-Division for inspiring Self-help groups, Cooperatives etc.
7. **DRCS:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed DRCS, Baksa to organize Honey farmers to form Cooperative Societies and to submit balance sheet of the Dakshin Bijni GPSS to the ADC I/c SDO (Civil) Salbari for audit purpose.
8. **PWD (Building Division) Baksa :** The Assistant Executive Engineer, PWD (Building Division), Baksa apprised the house that the Circuit House at Salbari Sub-Division has been lying abandoned and the department has already asked to the contractor concerned for completion of the work as soon as possible. Deputy Commissioner, Baksa instructed the AEE, PWD (Building) Division, Baksa that as the Salbari Circuit House is priority for District Administration, PWD Building is responsible for inspection of Circuit House and preparing a detailed report in the next DDC meeting. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed the AEE, PWD (Building) Division Baksa to inspect the stadium at Salbari and submit a detailed report to the DC.
9. **Transport :** The DTO, Baksa apprised in the house that as per the instructions received from CMO, a massive road safety drive has been carried out during the New year eve 31st December,2022 and 1st January,2023 under the district with the coordination of Magistrates/Police resulting in 60% decrease in the road accidents in comparison to last years.
10. **Sports :** The Deputy Commissioner asked the DSO, Baksa to propose the names of the players to the Govt. so that they will eligible for Assam Gourav/Assam Sourav/Assam Baibhav award.
11. **Forest:** The Deputy Commissioner asked the DFO, Baksa to finalize and settle the forest villages under FR Act before VC on 20th January, 2023. The SDO Civil, Salbari informed the DFO, Baksa that illegal mining is going on at Beki river and should be stopped immediately.
12. **Animal Husbandry & Veterinary:** The DVO Baksa apprised in the house that FMD vaccination have been completed. The Deputy Commissioner asked the DVO, Baksa that FMD/RD/IBD/PPR/ARV should be reflected in the PPT report target wise and percentage wise in the next DDC meeting.
13. **Sericulture:** Deputy Commissioner, Baksa asked the Asstt. Director Sericulture, Baksa to increase Muga Sector production.
14. **Handloom & Textiles:** The Asstt. Director Handloom & Textiles has informed the house that Pehchhan card has already been distributed amongst the beneficiary weavers.
15. **Town & Country Planning:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed Asstt. Director, Town & Country Planning, Baksa to prepare a Map for Mushalpur Municipal Board and also to find out ward wise population figures. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed Asstt. Director, Town & Country Planning to provide the name of ward along with population figures to the DRDA, FCS & CA , Baksa and to Election Officer, Baksa for the purpose of Delimitation.


The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
