OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER: BAKSA

Minutes of the meeting of District Development Committee for the month of December, 2022 of Baksa district held on 06/12/2022 at 11:00 a.m. in the Conference Hall of DC Baksa ::

The meeting was chaired by Smti. Masanda M. Pertin, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Baksa. At the very outset, she welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress of schemes department wise as per resolutions taken in the last meeting. Thereafter, threadbare discussions were held, based on which, the following resolutions were taken :-

1. **DRDA:** The Deputy Commissioner Baksa apprised the house that Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam has given priority status to Mission Amrit Sarovar. With regards to implementation of Amrit Sarovar scheme, 95 Nos. of schemes were proposed by DRDA, Baksa amongst which 87 schemes are feasible and 79 nos. DPRs have been prepared and submitted. Dr. A. Amin, ACS, ADC & I/c PD, DRDA, Baksa instructed Inspector of Schools and DEEO, Baksa to select Amrit Sarovar Schemes within the school boundary of LPS/MES/HS/HSS and Colleges which fit into the Mission Amrit Sarovar criteria. He also directed all Circle Officers to cooperate with BDOs for implementation of Amrit Sarovar Schemes by providing or identifying Govt. land. Deputy Commissioner instructed BDOs to start the work of Amrit Sarovar schemes immediately and instructed all BDOs to call Construction Committees members for a meeting and take up the issues of implementation of Amrit Sarovar in a mission mode so that all Amrit Sarovars are ready for inauguration by 26th January, 2023. The Deputy Commissioner instructed Executive Engineer, DRDA to coordinate with the Block level engineers for preparation of DPRs and uploading of the same. With regards to PMAY-G, ADC & I/c DRDA, Baksa instructed all BDOs to submit the list of eligible beneficiaries for taking up PMAY-G beneficiaries. The Deputy Commissioner requested PD, DRDA to prepare the action plan under MGNREGA for Baksa district. The Deputy Commissioner also apprised about the programme schedule with regards to 2nd Year anniversary celebrations of BTR Government and series of programmes to be held at Block level from 18/12/2022 onwards and requested all HoDs to cooperate for the smooth and successful conduct of the program.

(Action: BDOs, DSWO, IS, Baksa, EE, DRDA, HoDs)

2. **PHE ::** EE, PHE Baksa Division apprised the progress of works under JJM schemes. He said that overall 66 % progress has been achieved in the month of November, 2022. The Deputy Commissioner instructed EE, PHE to expedite all JJM work schemes within the work season so as to achieve the targets.

(Action : EE, PHE)

3. **Orunodoi:** Deputy Commissioner apprised the new guidelines of Orunodoi 2.0 scheme and also the timeline for implementation of Orunodoi 2.0. She instructed Joint Director of Health Services to submit the list of dwarf or ailing patients from Cerebral palsy / Thalassaemia / Hemophilia / Leprosy / Autism spectrum disorder. She suggested COs to prepare list of beggars within their respective Circles. She also instructed DSWO to submit the list of beneficiaries under DDDPA. Dr. A. Amin, ACS, ADC cum I/C PD, DRDA assured to submit the existing list of beneficiaries under IMUWPS and also apprised the house that Gram Sabha should be arranged by BDOs from 15th Dec/2022 to 31st Dec/2022 and instructed to submit the schedule of Gram Sabhas immediately. The Deputy Commissioner instructed COs to issue genuine income certificate. She also instructed all BDOs to prepare banners in English, Assamese and Bodo language for publicity of inclusion, exclusion, and priority criteria of Orunodoi 2.0 scheme for the upcoming Gram Sabhas.

(Action: COs / BDOs/DSWO)

4. **Social Welfare:** Smt. Banti Talukdar, ACS, ADC apprised the house that 4 nos of Model AWCs has been completed out of 22 nos. She also instructed DSWO to visit the site and assured that the fund will be released very shortly. The Deputy Commissioner instructed to complete the work of Model AWCs within January, 2023 complete with Nutri Garden. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed DSWO to submit the list of AWCs to PHE and APDCL for providing drinking water and electricity.

(Action: DSWO)

5. Agriculture: DAO apprised the house regarding progress of various schemes under Agriculture Department. He also apprised that five nos. of Paddy Procurement Centres have been sanctioned by the Govt. at Debachara, Bhotepowabari, Mushalpur, Subhankhata and Ananda Bazar. He apprised that the Govt. has set target for Baksa at 21000 MT. The Deputy Commissioner instructed all COs to visit PPCs regularly and instructed to achieve the target. With regard to poor performance of Farmers Registration Certificate, the Deputy Commissioner strictly instructed the Circle Officers and ADOs to verify the land documents of the farmers so as to enable them to get Farmers Registration Certificate and increase the numbers of Farmers selling paddy to PPCs.

6. Water Resource: EE, Water Resource, Baksa Division apprised the progress of schemes implemented through their Department. The Deputy Commissioner instructed the Water Resource Baksa Division to submit the list of ongoing schemes with their status.
(Action: EE, WR)
7. Soil Conservation: Divisional Officer Soil Conservation, Department Baksa informed the house that there are 2 nos. of schemes taken up in RIDF -XXVI amongst which, one is completed and another one is going on. She also apprised that there are 10 nos. of schemes taken up under RIDF-XXVII amongst which, 2 nos. are completed and 1 no. of Work is going on and for 2 nos. of schemes, foundation stone was laid by Hon'ble Minister to the Govt. of Assam, Shri U.G Brahma. Remaining five nos. of works are not started due to standing Paddy crops in the field. DO, Soil Conservation, informed that seven nos. of schemes were sanctioned by the state Govt. under SOPD during 2021-22 and 1 No. of scheme has achieved 50% progress and remaining 6 nos. are in initial stage.

8. Irrigation: EE, Irrigation Barama-Chapaguri Divn. informed that all the schemes implemented by the Division have been handed over schemes by erstwhile Divisions. Total 117 nos. of schemes have been taken up under the Division and 92 nos. are completed. Remaining 25 nos. of schemes is going on. 22406 hectares irrigation potential areas are created under the division.
(Action: EE, Irrigation Barama-Chapaguri Divn.)
9. Health: Joint Director, Health Services informed that immunisation programme is ongoing. Smti Banti Talukdar, ACS, Health instructed to complete the construction works of ICU at Dr. Ravi Boro Civil Hospital in all aspects for inauguration immediately and she also instructed to release honorarium of the Asha Workers on time. The Deputy Commissioner, Baksa requested all the HoDs present in the house to adopt one T.B Patient each under Nikshay Poshan Yojana component of PM TB Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan and provide helping hand to them by providing nutritious food as per their own capacity.
(Action: JDHS and HoDs)
10. Veterinary: Deputy Commissioner instructed DV&AHO to continue the vaccination of Food and Mouth Disease and Brucella.
(Action: DVO)
11. Sericulture: Deputy Commissioner instructed the Asstt. Director, Sericulture to distribute Pehchaan Card to Eri and Muga- Farmers by 2nd Week of December, 2022.
(Action: Asstt. Director, Sericulture)
12. Fishery: DFDO, Baksa apprised the progress of various schemes which are ongoing under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) and RIDF -XXVI. The Deputy Commissioner took stock of the all activities and instructed to complete all flagship schemes under PMMSY in stipulated time.
(Action: DFDO)
13. PWD (R&B): EE, PWD (R&B) explained the progress and status of ongoing schemes under Assam Mala Project, Good Will Project, SOPD, RIDF, Assam Darshan, TSP, ASRP. Deputy Commissioner, Baksa instructed EE, PWD (R&B) to complete all the schemes in time and improve the quality of roads under the district.
(Action: PWD (Roads))
14. Handlooms & Textiles: Deputy Commissioner instructed the Asstt. Director, Handlooms & Textiles to distribute total 8399 nos. of Pehchaan Cards amongst the Handloom Weavers which have been received from Weavers Service Centre, Khanapara, Guwahati to enable them to avail Govt. subsidy benefit.
(Action: Asstt. Director, H&T)

15. DRCS:: Deputy Commissioner instructed DRCS to submit a report on Registration of SHG/Societies and also instructed her to encourage the Ex-Militants for formation of Cooperative Societies so that they may be quickly assimilated back into the mainstream.
(Action: DRCS)
16. Library: District Librarian was instructed to keep the fans in a safe custody which have been donated by the owner of the Doomni Tea estate under CSR initiative for Mission Vidyanjali- an initiative of Education Department, Govt. of Assam so that it can be distributed ceremonially amongst the Headmasters of various schools under Baska Education Block.
(Action: Dist. Librarian)
17. Supply: Deputy Commissioner instructed Dy. Director, FCS & CA, Baksa to release the lifting, Transportation and Commission cost to the BSS/GPSS including Fair Price Shops in time.
(Action: Dy. DS, FCS & CA)
18. DICC: Deputy Commissioner instructed GM, DICC to submit the proposals under PMEGP to the concerned Banks through LDM for sanction of the same.
(Action: GM, DICC)
19. Town & Country Planning: Asstt. Director T &CP apprised that the Administrative approval for construction of Office Building of T&CP has already been accorded and e-Tendering invited by CHD Urban Development, BTC and also apprised that the proposal for Barama MB has been submitted to BTC authority for approval.
(Action: Asstt. Director, T&CP)
20. Education:: Deputy Commissioner instructed Inspector of Schools, Baksa to submit all the status of the ongoing and completed schemes under Education Department and also directed him to smoothly conduct the ceremonial distribution of fans amongst the Head Masters of various schools of Baska Education Blocks under Mission Vidyanjali Scheme donated by owner of Doomni Tea Estate under CSR initiative and ensure that they are uploaded in the Vidyanjali Portal along with the name of Donor.
(Action: IS, Baksa)
21. Forest: DFO, Baksa apprised the house that an amount of Rs. 6,17,13,650.00 (Rupees six crore seventeen lakh thirteen thousand six hundred and fifty) only has been collected for the year 2022 -23 upto November from Timber and Minor Minerals and also stated that Plantation program under APFBC scheme are going on at Salbari Range for 90 hectares and Batabari Range for 50 hectares. During 2022-23 under CAMPA scheme, for raising of site nursery creation including vacancy filling for three years, 50 hectares area at Salbari Range has been sanctioned by the Govt. and work is in progress. One scheme of Solar fencing is also going on at Batabari Range for 1 Km. under SOPD scheme.
(Action : DFO)
