MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE OF THE MONTH FEBRUARY, 2023 OF BAKSA DISTRICT HELD ON 13/02/2023 AT 11:00 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF OFFICE OF THE SUB-DIVISIONAL OFFICER, TAMULPUR:


The meeting was chaired by Smti. Masanda M. Pertin, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Baksa and at the very outset, she welcomed all officers present in the meeting.

The Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress of the developmental schemes department wise as per resolutions taken in the last meeting which was held in the Conference Hall of the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Baksa on 06/01/2023. The Deputy Commissioner, Baksa requested all the Heads of the line departments to prepare the monthly progress report jointly of Tamulpur and Baksa Sub-Division. Thereafter, threadbare discussions took place in the house and the resolutions adopted are as follows:

1. **DRDA:** The ADC & I/C PD, DRDA apprised the house about the progress of all the major schemes related to DRDA. He also informed that a ceremonial distribution of PMAY-G will be held on 16th February, 2023 at Mushalpur and also intimated that PMAY-G Houses will be distributed amongst 10 nos. of beneficiaries have from each VCDC. He also informed that third installments of PMAY houses for 30,321 nos. have been released and will be completed next week.
2. **PIIE:** The Deputy Commissioner entrusted the Assistant Commissioner, Baksa Smti. Gunjana Saikia to look after the overall progress of JJM schemes of JJM and SBM-G and also to expedite and review the same with all concerned departments such P&RD and ASRLM. The Deputy Commissioner also appealed to all Blocks to open new bank accounts for the fund of Jal Mitras and SBM-G. The Deputy Commissioner instructed all the Circle Officers to identify Govt. land for construction of Plastic Waste Management Unit and MCF (Material Collection Facility). The Deputy Commissioner also instructed the Section Officers and BPMs of ASRLM to constitute Water Users Committee by holding Gram Sabhas including providing training to 05(five) Women Members for Water Testing Purpose from each and every village.
3. **Social Welfare Officer:** Deputy Commissioner instructed the District Social Welfare Officer, Baksa to complete the construction of all Model Anganwadis as soon as possible. She also appealed to adopt at least one Anganwadi Centre to all HoDs of line departments under Tamulpur Sub-Division and also encouraged to celebrate every special occasions or birthday in these adopted Anganwadi Centres.
4. **Health:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed concerned ADC (Health) of Tamulpur Sub-Division and Joint Director, Health Services, Baksa to increase percentage of immunization at Tamulpur Sub-Division. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed Joint Director Health Services and Supply department Baksa to include 3000 beneficiaries daily under PMJAY Scheme. The Deputy Commissioner informed the house about the visit of a Central Team for Spot Study Tour of PM-Awards scheme related to health sector.
5. **Food, Supply & Consumer Affairs:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed the I/c Dy. Director Supply to expedite process of including new NFSA beneficiaries.
6. **Education:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed Inspector of Schools and DEEO, Baksa to implement Project Arohan through Arohan Portal and upload as mentor and register. She also instructed all HoDs of line departments to register their Officers in the Arohan portal as mentors. The Deputy Commissioner also asked the house to give more focus on certain schemes related to Education Department such as Mission Vidyanjali, Mission Utkarsha and PM-Shree Award.
7. **Agriculture:** The District Agriculture intimated that 2(two) nos. of PPC (Paddy Procurement Centre) were established under Tamulpur Sub-Division. The Deputy Commissioner highlighted that Paddy Procurement is one of the topmost priorities of the Govt. and all stakeholders are to expedite the process.

8. **DICC:** The Deputy Commissioner reviewed the performance of PMEGP loan sanctioned in the district. She instructed LDM to increase the sanctioning of loans under PMEGP. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed to convene or initiate a Trade Mela / Loan Mela at VCDC level.
9. **PWD (Building Division) Baksa :** The Assistant Executive Engineer, PWD (Building Division), Baksa apprised the house about the progress of the construction of the Circuit House at Salbari Sub-Division and also intimated that concerned contractors have been already communicated for completion of the construction of Circuit House at Salbari Sub-Division and stadium at Salbari as soon as possible.
10. **Transport:** The DTO, Baksa apprised the house that 62.34 % Percent of road accidents decreased in Baksa district. Tax Collection is going on smoothly as desired.
11. **Sports:** The Deputy Commissioner informed the house that 4th International Kho-Kho Championship will be held at Tamulpur Sub-Division for which preparation will be done as per international standards so no issue should arise for conduct of the same and asked ADC I/c Tamulpur Sub-Division to prepare a Master Plan for law & order with the coordination of SP, Baksa and Tamulpur take a review of the preparations.
12. **Forest:** The Deputy Commissioner asked the DFO, Baksa to take necessary action against illegal mining in the district. The Deputy Commissioner instructed DFO, Baksa to start the FRA process along with the concerned Circle Officers.
13. **Animal Husbandry & Veterinary:** The DVO Baksa apprised the house that 95% Percent of FMD vaccinations have been completed.
14. **Handloom & Textiles:** The Asstt. Director Handloom & Textiles informed the house that all SOPD Schemes have been completed and under Swa-Nirbhar Naari programme, procurement of Gamosa / Aronai is going on. The Deputy Commissioner instructed the Asstt. Director, Handlooms & Textiles Baksa to distribute Pehehaan Cards in Tamulpur Sub-Division.
15. **Town & Country Planning:** The Asstt. Director, Town & Country Planning informed the house that the drainage plan of Goreswar MB has been completed and construction of Cremation ground at Belguri under Mushalpur MB is under construction.


The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
