4.	Reforms, Governance Facilitation & Regulation	Forest	The District Commissioner has directed the Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) to halt all illegal mining activities within the district. The DFO reported that this year, a target of 800,000 (Eight Lakh) nursery plantations has been set under the CAMPA schemes, with 50% of the target already achieved. Additionally, the District Commissioner has instructed the DFO to clear trees at the JNV Field to create a landing area for the Helicopter of the Hon'ble Chief Minister. Furthermore, she has also directed the removal of trees that are obstructing the main		Forest Department

Social Sector	Welfare	The District Social Welfare Officer (DSWO) reported to the assembly that there are still 23 Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) awaiting connection through the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) schemes, and 17 AWCs awaiting electricity connection. In AWCs without electricity, solar lights will be installed. The District Commissioner has directed that students should not be selected for Anganwadi worker and helper positions. 6.	Social Sector	FPD& CA	The Deputy Director of Supply informed the house that the National Food Security Act (NFSA) data has been fully updated and no new data entry has been started.	FPD & CA Department
7.	Social Sector	EXCISE	The District Commissioner has directed the Superintendent of Excise to meet the tax collection target set by the government. Additionally, the Excise department has been tasked with developing a road map to combat the distribution of illegal liquor. This plan is to be submitted to Shri Ankur	Excise Department

9.	Infrastructure	APDCL	The AGM of APDCL has informed us that the electricity office dues have been received from the BTC Government. However, the specific departments for which the bill has been paid by the BTC authority have not been mentioned. In response, the District Commissioner has instructed all Heads of Departments to promptly communicate with the BTC authority to ensure the payment of electricity dues for their respective offices. Furthermore, the District Commissioner has directed APDCL to ensure that electricity connections are established in all polling stations. Additionally, they have been instructed to obtain a list of polling stations from the Election Office. The District Commissioner has also requested APDCL to install high	APDCL authority

			voltage transformers at Bhutankhuti village in place of the current transformers for the Serena Honey Processing Centre project. Furthermore, she has asked APDCL to address the electricity issues in the Baganpara area.

Infrastructure	PWD (Roads)	The Executive Engineer of the PWD (Roads) provided an update on the progress of various schemes being implemented as part of the Goodwill project, SOPD-G, SOPD-FDR, RIDF, Assam Darxan, SCSP, MMPPNA, MMUPNA SOPD-BTC, and PMGSY programmes. He reported that 79 out of 90 roads have been completed under the Goodwill Projects, and 60 out of 66 roads have been completed under SOPD-G. During the discussion, the Executive Engineer of the Public Works Department (Roads & Bridges) mentioned that the tendering process has been finalized for the Thakurchuba Road project under the Asom Mala scheme.
