MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE OF THE MONTH
MARCH, 2023 OF BAKSA DISTRICT HELD ON 10/03/2023 AT 11:00 A.M. IN THE
CONFERENCE HALL OF OFFICE OF THE SUB-DIVISIONAL OFFICER, SALBARI:

The meeting was chaired by Smti. Masanda M. Pertin, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Baksa and at the very outset, she welcomed all officers present in the meeting. The Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress of the developmental schemes department wise. After a threadbare discussions the following resolutions are adopted as below::

- 1. DRDA::** a) **PMAY-G::** The Deputy Commissioner, Baksa reviewed the progress of PMAY-G and apprised the house that all the first Installments of PMAY-G should be cleared immediately.
b) **Amritsarvar:** The Deputy Commissioner apprised the house that BDOs should complete and upload the data of completed works on BISAG-N portal.
- 2. PMJAY-** The Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress of PMJAY and instructed Smti. Nizwra Boro, ACS, AC to look after the implementation of PMJAY in Mushalpur Sub-Division, Smti. Anusmita Dutta, ACS, AC, Baksa in Salbari Sub-Division and Smti Kukila Gogoi, ACS, ADC in Tamulpur Sub-Division were entrusted to lead the PMJAY campaign in their respective Sub-Divisions.
- 3. Child Marriage Victims:** The Deputy Commissioner informed the house that the counseling for Child Marriage victims will be held on 13/03/2023 at Mushalpur for providing Health Care/ Child growth monitoring/ providing food packages to the victims of Child Marriage. She also instructed PD, DRDA and Dy. Director, FCS & CA, Baksa to include all Child Marriage victims under NFSA from Supply Department and to include Orunodoi 2.0 Scheme. The Deputy Commissioner instructed LDM, Baksa to include them in all Financial Inclusion schemes and open Bank account against every Child Marriage victims. She also instructed the LDM to arrange VCDC wise at least 2(two) nos. of Gram-Sabhas per week for increase of financial inclusion and Social Security Schemes and asked BDOs to support as per meeting schedule. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed Inspector of Schools, Baksa to engage all Child Marriage Victim children in Residential Schools. The Inspector of Schools assured that the Child Marriage Victim Children will be accommodated in the Kasturba Gandhi Residential School at Tamulpur.
- 4. Orunodoi ::** The Deputy Commissioner, Baksa apprised the house that a new order has come from Finance Department of Govt. of Assam with regard to subsuming the beneficiaries of schemes of Deen Dayal Dibyangjan Pension Scheme and Indira Miri Universal Widow Pension Schemes under Orunodoi 2.0 and the details of Common (with Orunodoi original list of beneficiaries), dead, untraceable, bogus beneficiaries from existing list of these subsumed schemes should be scrutinized nicely countersigned by the BDOs and submitted as per prescribed format to the Office of the Deputy Commissioner for taking further necessary action.
- 5. Social Welfare::** The DSWO informed the house about the completion Model AWCs. As stated by him, in Chapaguri LAC, 6 nos. of Model AWCs are completed and in Tamulpur, 11 nos. of Model AWCs are completed. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed all COs to visit and inspect Model AWCs in their respective jurisdictions and to share pictures with GPS location with the GIS Expert, O/o PD, DRDA Baksa for maintaining the digital tour dairy.
- 6. Water Resources:** The Ex. Engineer, WR Division Baksa apprised the progress of the schemes in the house. The Deputy Commissioner instructed all Circle Officers to visit all Flood related SDRF schemes in their respective jurisdictions before arrival of flood season and also instructed EE, WR, Division Baksa to complete all schemes before flood season. The Deputy Commissioner asked to call upon Executive Engineer, WR, Tamulpur Division in the next DDC Meeting.
- 7. Soil Conservation:** The Divisional Officer, Soil Conservation apprised the progress of schemes in the house along with the schemes pertaining to Salbari Sub-Division. The Deputy Commissioner instructed DO Soil Conservation to share all the schemes with the Circle Officers and also instructed to complete all the schemes before rainy season.
- 8. PWD Roads :** The Deputy Commissioner instructed Ex Engineer, PWD Roads to take necessary steps and measures for temporary restoration of Arnibil, Sirishbari, Subankhata and Chamuahati before flood season. The EE, PWD Roads informed in the house that Barama College Road is already sanctioned and preliminary work order is provided to the Contractor and final work order will be provided as soon as deposit of security money. The Deputy Commissioner instructed Smt. Kukila Gogoi, ACS, ADC Tamulpur to inspect all schemes under PWD Roads in Tamulpur and Nagrijuli.

9. **PWD Building:** The Asstt. Executive Engineer, PWD Building Division apprised the house that Model Degree College Barimakha is 80% completed. The AEE, PWD Buildings said that the contractor of Circuit House of Salbari Sub-Division has been communicated and the contractor assured to complete the remaining works at an early date.
10. **Veterinary:** The DVO apprised the progress of schemes under veterinary department. Deputy Commissioner instructed DVO to take-over all newly constructed Sub- Centres of veterinary. Deputy Commissioner instructed DVO to take initiative for establishment of Dairy Farm in Baksa district and also instructed to communicate with the Dairy Development Department. The DVO apprised in the house that no Bird flu symptoms have been identified in the district till now.
11. **Co-operative Societies:** The DRCS apprised in the house about the registration of Cooperative Societies, that there are 11 nos. of Cooperative Societies have been registered up to January,2023.
12. **Forest:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed the representative on behalf of DFO to stop illegal mining from the district. ADC Forest Shri Sanjeev Kr. Sharma, ACS informed the house that 18 nos. of Van Dhan Kendras have been running in Baksa district. The Deputy Commissioner instructed the DFO, Baksa to identify the FRA villages Circle wise and assist the concerned Circle Officers in joint verification of the FRA villages. The ADC I/c SDO Civil Salbari instructed Forest department to display signboards in Mining area and Mahals.
13. **DICC:** The GM, DICC apprised the house about the latest status of PMEGP Loans. The Deputy Commissioner instructed ADC I/c Tamulpur Sub-Division to look into the PMEGP schemes with consultation of all the bank branches in Tamulpur area. GM DICC apprised the house about PMFME under Atma Nirbhar Bharat and stated that target set up by the Govt. during the year 2023 is 120 and total 321 nos. of application received in online and same was forwarded to the Banks and out of them only 11 Nos. have been sanctioned for Rs. 45,96,082 /- .
14. **PHE:** The EE, PHE Baksa Division informed that the process of appointment of Jal Mitras are completed in Baska and Jalah Blocks and Deputy Commissioner instructed to release the remuneration of Jal Mitras as soon as possible. She also instructed all BDOs to open Bank account for JJM and SBM-G to receive fund from BTC. Total 4 nos. of PWMU are finalized in Baksa district at Kharua in Barama, Block Office Campus in Baska Dev. Block, Sontola in Nagrijuli and Ramechuburi in Tamulpur. The construction work of PWMU had started as informed by EE. PHE and concerned BDO. The Deputy Commissioner instructed that every Block should have a PWMU and every revenue village should have an MCF as per SBM-G guidelines. She asked Circle Officers to expedite identification and verification of land for the same.
15. **Sports:** The ADC I/c Tamulpur apprised the progress of 4th Asian Kho-Kho Championship to be held in Tamulpur H.S. The Deputy Commissioner instructed the DSO, Baksa , DTO, Baksa, Jt. DHS, PWD (Roads), PWD (Building), PHE to cooperate with the Administration of Tamulpur Sub-Division for the smooth conduct of 4th Asian Kho-Kho Championship. The ADC I/c Tamulpur requested Jt. DHS to submit requirement of a Cardiologist during the championship Match.
16. **Health:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed Jt. DHS to expedite E-KYC for PMJAY at the earliest.
17. **Handloom & Textiles:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed AD Handlooms & Textiles, Baksa and all Circle Officers to carry out special drive to prevent, production, import and sale of Power Loom made Gamosa, Mekhela –Chador, Dokhona, Aronai etc. in Baksa district.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
