OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER:.....BAKSA

Minutes of the meeting of District Development Committee for the month of November, 2022 of Baksa district held on 07/11/2022 at 11:00 a.m. in the Conference Hall of DC Baksa.

The meeting was chaired by Smti. M. Pertin, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Baksa and at the outset, she welcomed all officers present in the meeting.

The Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress of developmental schemes department wise and the following resolutions were adopted in the meeting.

1. **DRDA:** Dr. Ashraful Amin, ACS, I/c PD DRDA, Baksa informed the house about the progress of schemes implemented through DRDA. Deputy Commissioner instructed DRDA to conduct awareness programme for Aadhaar seeding of beneficiaries of NSAP, PMAY-G programme, etc. and also instructed all HoDs to incorporate the state average in their respective departmental report.

(Action:

2. **PHE :** The Executive Engineer explained JJM Scheme and other schemes implemented through PHE Baksa Division. Year wise FHTC coverage in Baksa District under JJM is shown below :

The Executive Engineer, PHE informed the house that 137 nos. of Users Committee has been formed out of 479 nos. of schemes and Bank Accounts has been opened against 137 nos. of Water Users Committee.

The Deputy Commissioner instructed BDOs to depute their engineers for inspection of JJM schemes of their respective Blocks and expedite the formation of Water Users Committees. Deputy Commissioner Baksa also instructed Section Officers of PHE and the BDOs to expedite the process of handing over of schemes to the Water Users Committee.

(Action: PHE & BDOs)

3. **Agriculture::** The District Agriculture Officer, Baksa explained the status of various schemes under Agriculture Department. The DAO intimated the house that 14007 applications have been received for new registration under the scheme PM KISAN SAMMAN NIDHI and verification of 19.75% have been conducted. The Project Director, DRDA intimated the house that 63 nos. of Godowns will be constructed in 63 VDCs in Baksa district and he requested to verify locations of Godowns by Agriculture Development Officer immediately.

(Action: Agriculture and All HODs)

4. **Forest:** The DFO Baksa intimated the house that 50 hectares of plantation under CAMPA fund will be created at Daodhara RF under Salbari Range and for that site Nursery to raising seedlings for plantation is going to be start shortly with a sanctioned amount of Rs. 20,62,500/-. He also intimated in the house that the plantation is going on under APFBC at Salbari for 90 hectares and Batabari Range for 50 hectares during 2021-22 by the Assam Gramin Vikas Agency. The status of revenue collection intimated by the DFO as follows ::

The DFO also said that Solar Fencing is going on at Batabari Range under SOPD scheme.

(Action: DFO, Baksa)

5. **Social Welfare:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed to complete all Model AWCs by November, 2022 and also to complete all aspects before inauguration of Model AWCs as specified in the estimates. The Deputy Commissioner suggested to create a Nutri-garden in all AWCs. The Deputy Commissioner also requested all HoDs to adopt one Anganwadi Centre and one SAM child. Smti. Banti Talukdar, ACS, ADC suggested DSWO to share the list of Anganwadi Centres with PHE and APDCL for providing water facility and electricity.

(Action :: DSWO, PHE, APDCL)

6. **Water Resource::** The Executive Engineer explained the schematic progress of the schemes under SDRF and requested to conduct spot verification from the Deputy Commissioner Office. Smti. Banti Talukdar, ACS, ADC suggested WR deptt. to verify the Jartaluk (Right embankment) project which was damaged during last flood season.

(Action :: Water Resource)

7. **DI&CC :** The GM, DICC apprised the house about the total nos. of sanctioned proposals under PMEGP schemes in Baksa district. He also stated that the Bank authority refused to sanction the proposed loan proposals although recovery position of Baksa district is normal and requested District Administration to cooperate for sanctioning the proposed proposals under PMEGP. The Deputy Commissioner instructed GM, DICC to conduct awareness programme in collaboration with the Handloom & Textile and Sericulture departments.

(Action: DI&CC, H&T, Sericulture).

8. **Health:** The Joint Director of Health Services explained the progress of schemes of health department schemes. The Deputy Commissioner instructed to complete the Daodhora MPHC for inauguration by December, 2022. The Deputy Commissioner instructed Dr. Ashraful Amin, ACS, ADC to inspect the Model Hospitals of Koklabari and Nimua. She also suggested Joint Director, Health Services to serve notice to the contractors for completion of the construction works immediately. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed Jt. Director of Health Services to participate in the PM Award for Excellence in Swasth Bharat (Healthy Bharat) category.

(Action: Health)

9. **Town & Country Planning:** The Asstt. Director, T&C Planning apprised that the office building of T&C Planning has been sanctioned and construction will be started very shortly. He also said that the proposal for creation of Barama Municipal Board has been submitted to the BTC. PD, DRDA suggested Asstt. Director, Town & Country Planning, Baksa to share the list of PMAY-U beneficiaries with DRDA while implementation of PMAY-U programme.

(Action: T&C Planning)

10. **Soil Conservation:** The Divisional Officer, Soil Conservation informed that 2(Two) nos of scheme sanction under RIDE-XXV at Kamardisa Soil Conservation Project and Water Harvesting and Erosion Control Project at Milan Bazar Barapeta Ultakhanda Dong, Barapeta village and the Kamardisa Soil Conservation Project has already been completed. She also apprised that 10(Ten)nos of projects has been sanctioned under RIDF-XXVII and 2(Two) nos. have already been completed and remaining are in initial stage. She said that 7(Seven) nos of scheme have been sanctioned under SOPD-G (State) and all are in initial stage for starting the works. The Divisional Officer also apprised that 1(One) project under Watershed Development Component-Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana(WDC-PMKSY) has been sanctioned covering an area of 6300 hecatres under Adla, Gerua, Baganpara, Kadamtal and Dakshin Kumarikata VDC.

(Action: Soil Conservation)

11. **Transport:** The DTO apprised that an amount of Rs.6,39,32,272/- revenue has been collected up to Oct/2022. The Deputy Commissioner instructed him to initiate the process for auction all unused damaged vehicles in Govt. offices.

(Action: DTO)

12. **Excise:** The Supdt. Of Excise apprised the house that the revenue collection has increased in Baksa district.

(Action: Excise Deptt.)

13. **Sericulture:** The Asstt. Director, H&T said that the target of Mudra Loan in Baksa district is 80 (Eighty) nos. out of which 50(Fifty) nos. are for Baksa Division and 30(Thirty) nos. for Salbari Division. The Deputy Commissioner instructed LDM Baksa to ensure Banks fulfill the target of 50 nos. by assigning each Banks their target. The Deputy Commissioner instructed to distribute Pechaan cards among the weavers and bring details of distribution of Pechaan card in next DDC meeting.

(Action: H&T)

14. **LDM:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed LDM to accept the proposals of PMEGP and also instructed to take initiative for sanctioning the proposals with higher authority. The Deputy Commissioner also advised to approve the Mudra Loan proposals. Dr. Ashraful Amin, ACS, ADC instructed LDM to give instruction to the Branch Managers for opening of Bank accounts for School children within the stipulated time.

(Action: LDM)

15. **Agriculture:** The DAO apprised the status of PM-Kisan beneficiaries. The Deputy Commissioner instructed DAO and EE Agriculture to submit detailed report in Agriculture Review meeting.

(Action: DAO & EE, Agril.)

15. **Supply:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed Asstt. Director, Supply to take initiative for timely release of Transportation Cost and Commission of PDS under NFSA.

(Action: Supply)

16. **PWD(R):** The EE PWD (R) informed about the progress of works taken up by PWD(R) department and he apprised that the Road from Mushalpur to Barbari towards Baganpara-Dhamdhama will be started very shortly. The Deputy Commissioner instructed EE PWD (R) to complete the work of Barama-Barama College road with bridge portion immediately.

(Action: PWD -Raods)

17. **A.H.&Vety:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed to increase the number of Animal Health and Vaccination camps in Baksa District.

(Action: Vety Deptt.)

18. **Co-Operative:** The DRCS informed that one Co-operative Society of Ex-NDFB for Rice is under process for Registration and another 84 (Eighty four) nos of co-operative societies has already been registered up to Sept/2022 in Baksa District. The Deputy Commissioner asked to share the list of Ex-NDFB co-operative societies with District Agriculture Officer.

(Action:DRCS)

19. **Library:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed District Librarian to communicate with higher authority for proposal of a District Auditorium in Baksa district.

20. **Education:** The Deputy Commissioner instructed Education Dept. to participate in PM Awards of Excellence through Samagra Shiksha.

(Action: District Library)

After threadbare discussion, the meeting ended with a resolution to hold the DDC meeting on 6th of every month (or on the next day if it falls on a holiday) and vote of thanks from the chair.
